



## **NOVEMBER 2024 UPDATE**

## 11-19-24 EPRD BOARD MEETING REPORT

On November 19, 2024, the EPRD Board of Directors considered several upcoming capital projects that have been prioritized from 2023 strategic planning and community input. Based on current information, the EPRD Board adopted preliminary plans, proposed funding strategies, and target timelines for each.

Proposed funding packages were developed using a combination of annual capital improvement appropriations, proceeds from the 6C mill levy extension approved by voters, future certificates of participation, and projected contributions from grants and donations. Proposed funding strategy and timelines are based on current cost estimates, market forecasts, availability of outside funding, organizational capacity, and opportunity, and are therefore subject to change. In all cases, EPRD's commitment to *TAKE CARE OF WHAT WE HAVE* has been maintained as a key component of all future planning.

The capital projects discussed by the EPRD Board are:

- Buchanan Park Improvements
- Buchanan Aquatics Expansion
- Buchanan Field House Addition
- Miscellaneous Other Projects








